Breathing Air Compressor and Storage System

Background

St. Louis Public Schools Fire & EMS, which conducts a Fire & EMS Academy for high school students in the St. Louis Public Schools District, is requesting proposals for a breathing air compressor and storage system. The equipment will be used by the school's Fire-EMS department and Academy. Proposals are requested on new equipment meeting the following specifications.

Scope of the Program

New equipment shall meet the following specifications:

Minimum 7-1/2 hp electric motor; 230 volt; 60 cycle; SINGLE phase

6000 psi capacity

Automatic condensate drain system

Capable of producing Grade E breathing air

Automatic start/stop pressure switch

Carbon monoxide monitor with automatic calibration

Completely enclosed unit allowing a MAXIMUM 72 dBa

Two (2), UN/ISO, 6000 psi storage bottles.

Bids shall include all shipping, delivery, and installation charges. SLPS Fire & EMS does not have the ability to unload this equipment from a truck. Pricing shall include all costs associated with the installation of this equipment, including all interconnecting piping from the compressor to the storage bottles.

Pricing shall include a 30 foot length of 6000 psi, high pressure hose to fill the storage cylinders on the department's fire truck. The fill hose shall include a bleed valve and shut off valve.

Cost of the Program

Bidders are cautioned that items and/or services must be furnished at the price submitted. No increase in price will be permitted during the term of the agreement.

Bid Evaluation

Each bid will be evaluated on the response to the items included on the list. The pricing on each item will be evaluated individually

Bid Due Date
