Popcorn Fundraiser



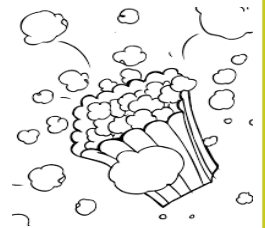
We are so excited!!!! Yummy popcorn is for sale again!
