SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Graduating senior (2014) from a public high school in the St. Louis Metropolitan Area
- ✓ Minimum of a 3.0 cumulative GPA (submit copy of official high school transcript)
- ✓ Submit an official document stating ACT and/or SAT score
- ✓ Acceptance into a college or university (provide copy of college admission letter)
- ✓ Minimum of 60 service hours within school and/or community (documentation required)
- ✓ 3 letters of recommendation 2 academic references (teacher, counselor, administrator) and 1 personal reference (<u>cannot</u> be a relative)
- ✓ Submit a 1-2 page, double spaced, 12 point font essay on the topic, "How Furthering My Education Will Assist In Accomplishing My Ultimate Goals"
- ✓ Finalist will be notified via telephone to schedule an interview with the committee during the week of May 12, 2014
- ✓ Scholarship recipient and one guest will be invited to attend the Zeta Sigma Scholarship Brunch on Saturday, June 14, 2014
