Key Accomplishments

Completed all Kitchen / Cafeteria upgrades

Serving freshly prepared meals at every school – no more component meals!

Successfully transitioned to Southwest Food Service Excellence:

- The team has been flexible and responsive to every request SLPS has made
- Successfully completed the summer feeding program
- > Hired over 330 staff members
- Provided training and staff development resulting in higher level of service and quality food preparation
- > Participated in the 2013 Back to School Fair
- Merchandised over 70 kitchens
- > Successfully completed the start-up of the 21 new kitchens
- Added salad bars in every school
- Improved merchandising, quality and taste



Tracking ahead of pace vs. last year in collecting meal applications due to:

- Schools received meal applications earlier
- >Worked closely with Associate Superintendents, Principals and School Staff
- ➤ More frequent and updated Direct Certification lists from Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) and also created Direct Certification sibling matches
- Increased usage of the online application website
- ➤ Use of automatic call out system to parents

As of November 4, we achieved our goal of 99% processed applications

Lunch Participation	75%	77%	78%	78%	80%


Participation rates are improving due to:

2013-14 Focus Areas

- Link the cafeteria to the classroom through effective partnerships with school nutrition professionals and teachers
- Roving Chef visits in all schools
- AIM for Fitness events
 - 2.2 million dollars over three years
 - Purpose of grant: to increase physical activity and improve nutrition education among St. Louis Public Schools students
- Continue to survey students, principals and staff and use feedback to maintain menu improvements
