The undersigned HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Released Parties and each of them from any loss, damage, or cost (including attorney's fees) they may incur due to the presence or participation of the undersigned in the Event and whether caused by the negligence, gross negligence or intentional misconduct of the Released Parties or otherwise. 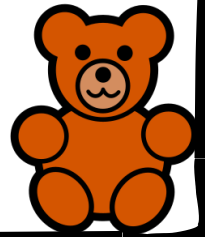
