#### 11th Annual Golf Scramble















#### **Charles Sumner (January 6, 1811 – March 11, 1874)**




Charles Sumner was an American politician and senator from Massachusetts. An academic lawyer and a powerful orator, Sumner was the leader of the antislavery forces in Massachusetts and a leader of the Radical Republicans in the United States Senate during the American Civil War and Reconstruction working to control the ex-Confederates and guarantee equal rights to the Freedmen.

Our beloved Sumner High opened in 1875, the first high school opened for African-Americans west of the Mississippi; named after well-known abolitionist senator Charles E. Sumner.



## **Preventing Heart Disease - At Any Age**

You're never too young or too old to take care of your heart.

Preventing heart disease (and all cardiovascular diseases) means making smart choices now that will pay off the rest of your life. Lack of exercise, a poor diet and other bad habits can take their toll over the years. Anyone at any age can benefit from simple steps to keep their heart healthy during each decade of life. Here's how: **Choose a healthy eating plan.** 

The food you eat can decrease your risk of heart disease and <u>stroke</u>. Choose foods low in <u>saturated fat, trans</u> fat, <u>cholesterol</u>, <u>sodium</u> and <u>added sugars and sweeteners</u>. As part of a healthy diet, <u>eat plenty of fruits and vegetables</u>, <u>fiber-rich whole grains</u>, <u>fish</u> (preferably oily fish -- at least twice per week), nuts, legumes and seeds. Also try eating some <u>meals without meat</u>. Select fat-free and low-fat dairy products and lean meats and poultry (skinless). Limit sugar-sweetened beverages. **Be physically active.** You can slowly work up to at least 2½ hours (150 minutes) of moderate-intensity aerobic physical activity (like brisk walking) every week or an hour and 15 minutes (75 minutes) of vigorous intensity aerobic physical activity (such as jogging or running) or a combination of both every week. Additionally, on two or more days a week you need muscle-strengthening activities that work all major muscle groups (legs, hips, back, abdomen, chest shoulders and arms).
