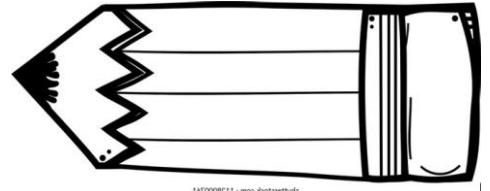

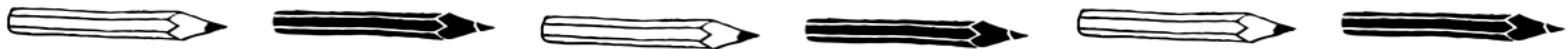
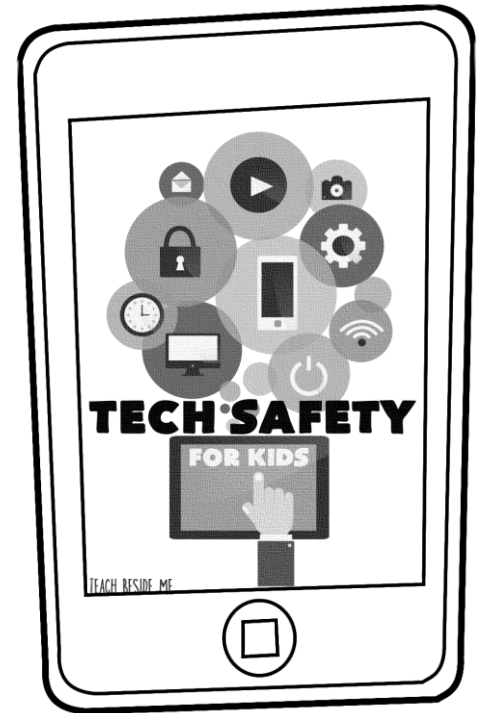

iPad Classroom Policy:

Having an iPad is a privilege. It is a tool that will not only help you in your learning, but it will teach you skills that are necessary in most jobs today. Your iPad is the property of the school district but is your **RESPONSIBILITY** and we expect every student to take good care of them.

iPad Expectations:

- Your iPad is your responsibility.
- Do not add any stickers or any other decorative items.
- Do not mess with school labels on the iPad.
- Do not remove the case from the iPad.
- Use both hands when using the iPad.
- Make sure that your iPad is stored somewhere safe at home & at school (away from liquids, away from food/sticky items, not near edges where it may be knocked down, etc.).
- Your iPad should always be in the protective case provided to you.
- Anything you do on the Internet (on any device) is visible to someone!
- Pictures, music, etc., on your iPad should be appropriate for school.
