English Language Arts: We are in Alphabet Bootcamp. We will introduce a new letter and its sound every day. All of our activities will be built around the letter of the day. This week's letters are O,P,Q,R,S.

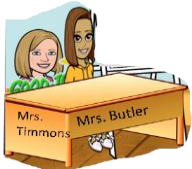
Math: We are in Math Bootcamp. We will learn number names, number order, 1 to 1 counting, comparing quantities and more.

Science/Social Studies: We will make observations and use vocabulary to discuss physical properties of objects such size, shape and color. We will also practice the Pledge of Allegiance each morning and learn to identify the United States flag.

What to bring: Students can bring a water bottle. Please do not put the water in same area as iPad. Students can bring a snack to have in the afternoon.

Homework: The homework is a general review packet. If it is too difficult, your child may be having difficulty in class. If it is too easy, your child is probably able to complete classwork on their own. **Parents only need to return the signed top page when completed.**
