QUALIFICATIONS:

- -Household income may not exceed 135% of federal poverty guidelines
- -Households with a member that is at least 60 years old or with special needs (including children) can apply for LIHEAP assistance beginning October 1, 2020
- -Applications for all others will be accepted beginning November 1, 2020 DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED:
- ✓ Full Social Security Number(s) on signed application and copy of Social Security Card(s) for people who don't receive food stamps.
- Proof of all household income from the previous month if you are not currently receiving Food Stamps or proof of income for any household member(s) not on your Food Stamp case.
- ✓ Copy of current utility bills/disconnection notices for Spire and Ameren.
