Daily, on-time attendance is critical for your child's academic and social development. All students are expected to attend school 95% of time or more!

School hours are **9:10 AM-4:07 PM** during the 2021-2022 school year. All students will enter the building through Door 5(Gym), beginning at 8:50 AM. Breakfast is provided for all students each day.

The school day ends at 4:07 PM. Students who are pick-up may be picked up beginning at 3:50 PM from their designated location (Door 7= 2nd Grade- 6th Grade, Front Entrance= KG- 1st Grade, and Door 2= Pre K). If you need to change your child's transportation on any given day, please communicate this change to the main office by 3:00 PM.
