I will check my email throughout the day (before school, during planning/nap, and before dismissal) so this will be the most reliable way to reach me in the case of a transportation change, question, concern, etc. If you need to call me during the school day, please call the school number and the office will forward you to me.

<u>Snack Calendar:</u> Our classroom will participate in a **Snack Calendar** this year. Each month a calendar will be posted identifying which day your child will bring snack. Snack should be individually packaged, nonperishable, and come in quantities of at least 20 total. You are free to bring in snack early, but please do so <u>no more than a week in advance</u>. If you do not wish to participate in the Snack Calendar, please let me know and instead send your child with their own individual snack each day.

<u>Homework:</u> Your child will have homework while enrolled in Saint Louis Public Schools. Our classroom homework is to **READ** together **EVERY** night. Details on tracking systems will be given later. Occasional home activities may be sent home as well.

<u>Student Attire:</u> Mason ACL follows a Dress-Code Policy which is laid out in detail in the Student Handbook. Please refer to this policy for guidance on student attire.

<u>Open House</u>: Open House will be in-person at Mason again this year! We hope to see you here for the Open House on <u>August 15th from 3:00 to 5 pm.</u> Please join us for an opportunity to not only meet me, but to catch a glimpse of your student's learning environment for the 2024-2025 school year.
