School Parent and Family Engagement Policy

Methods by which the school promotes and provides parental engagement:

- School resource center is available to parents during school hours, which provides information regarding but not limited to DESE and Title 1 program guidelines

- Parent-Teacher conferences at the end of each semester
- The Family Community Specialist will contact the parents of students with chronic absentees
- Academic Coach provides information on the curriculum and content that is aligned with the MAP
- Provide student expectations and appropriate behavior
- The principal involves parents in the planning and review of the PIP
- Title 1 Review and Revision meeting
- Link families with needed resources via the school social worker

Methods of Communication Employed to Inform Parents of Opportunities:

- The Family and Community Specialist is the main point of contact for parental engagement
- Phone calls home made by staff and an automatic dialing system
- Emails

- Telephone calls
- Postal service
- Letters sent home with students
- Virtual School Meetings
- Important phone numbers (i.e. school, transportations, central office) will be provided in monthly newsletter, and are available online and on a variety of SLPS publications
- Grades can be accessed online by a parent via parent portal

Parental Accountability:

- Attend parent-teacher conferences virtually
- Call if a meeting/conference must be canceled or rescheduled
- Attend at least one parent engagement event per school year (more if schedule and transportation permit)
- Call the school when the student is absent; send appropriate documentation
- Voice opinions, comments, concerns, and questions via one of the parental engagement opportunities or communication avenues (phone calls, virtual school meeting, etc.)
- Ensure that their students(s) attend school every day (maintain a minimum of 90% attendance rate)
