Oak Hill Elementary School recognizes that parental involvement is essential if we are going to achieve academic excellence for our students. We realize that parents will support the school if we let them know our needs and concerns. To increase the home-school connection support, Oak Hill is committed to providing families with written documents in their native language as much as possible for our English Language Learners (ELL). This plan will serve as a guide for the involvement of parents working with the school to benefit the students.

1. Strategies for Involvement

Oak Hill Elementary will:

- Sponsor their annual Title 1 Meeting in August, 2021 to explain Title 1 requirements and parents' rights. The Family and Community Specialist will facilitate the meeting with the support of the Principal.
- Offer monthly parent meetings to share ideas and develop plans to support and improve academic achievement at Oak Hill School. These meetings are facilitated by the Family and Community Specialist. All dates and times, are posted each month in the school's bi-monthly newsletter. Parent reminders are sent home in the parent's native language.
- Sponsor 1st and 2nd semester Title 1 Review Parent Meetings in August 2021 and March 2022. The meeting will be facilitated by the Family and Community Specialist and the Principal. At each meeting, parents and staff will review, revise and make suggestions for Oak Hill School Title 1 Engagement Policy and Title 1 Tutoring Programs.
- Provide communication to parents about Title 1 Services through:
 - Oak Hill bi-monthly newsletter
 - Classroom Teacher's quarterly progress reports
 - Written communication in Parent's Native Language
 - Parent Meetings
 - Parent/Teacher Conferences



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- Provide parents the opportunity to ask questions and express concerns about their child's participation in the following Title 1 sponsored programs at Oak Hill:
 - Communication Arts Tutoring
 - Mathematics Tutoring
 - Perfect Attendance Initiative


2. Shared Responsibilities for High Student Academic Achievement


Oak Hill has developed a school-parent compact, which outlines the shared responsibilities of the school, parent, and student.
