## What happens when someone contacts BHR?

- A Masters Level or licensed clinician will help you or someone you know through an emotional crisis
- Clinicians are available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year
- Provide easy emergency access to mental health services
- When appropriate, arrange a face to face meeting with a Mobile Outreach counselor
- Give you the skills necessary to connect with community resources
- Assist with hospitalization if needed
