



Inclement Weather and Emergency Guidelines

PLAN A AMI Day

Alternative Methods of Instruction (AMI) day is when we teach and work from home due to weather-related events.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR — STUDENTS —

Students will not report to school.
Students will receive AMI Day Instruction.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR — STAFF —

School-based staff may work remotely or from their school building. Administrators, Central Office, Secretaries, and Operations Department who are all 12-month staff will receive details from supervisors.

PLAN B Snow Day

A traditional snow day is when we call off school due to inclement weather.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR — STUDENTS —

NO SCHOOL Students will not report to school. Students will not receive virtual instruction.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR — STAFF —

Operations Department reports to work. 12-month staff will receive details from supervisors.

PLAN C Emergency

The Superintendent may declare an "Emergency Day" when weather conditions are unsafe for travel.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR — STUDENTS —

NO SCHOOL Students will not report to school. Students will not receive virtual instruction.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR — STAFF —

Operations Department will be on standby and will receive details from supervisors. 12-month staff will receive details from supervisors.
