- SLPS operates and maintains
 - o 74 active school buildings
 - 46 Elementary Schools (11 of these are Magnet Schools)
 - 12 Middle Schools (6 of these are Magnet Schools)
 - 16 High Schools (5 of these are Magnet Schools & 3 of these are Choice Schools)
 - o 3 programs
 - The Innovation Concept Academy @ Blewett, Alternative Education South @ Lyon, and Fresh Start Academy
 - 39 decommissioned buildings
 - 13 building decommissioned in summer of 2009
- Buildings range from 6 to 132 years old, and most are more than 75 years old

Transportation:

- 370 bus routes currently in operation
- Average daily ridership is approximately 14,000 students
