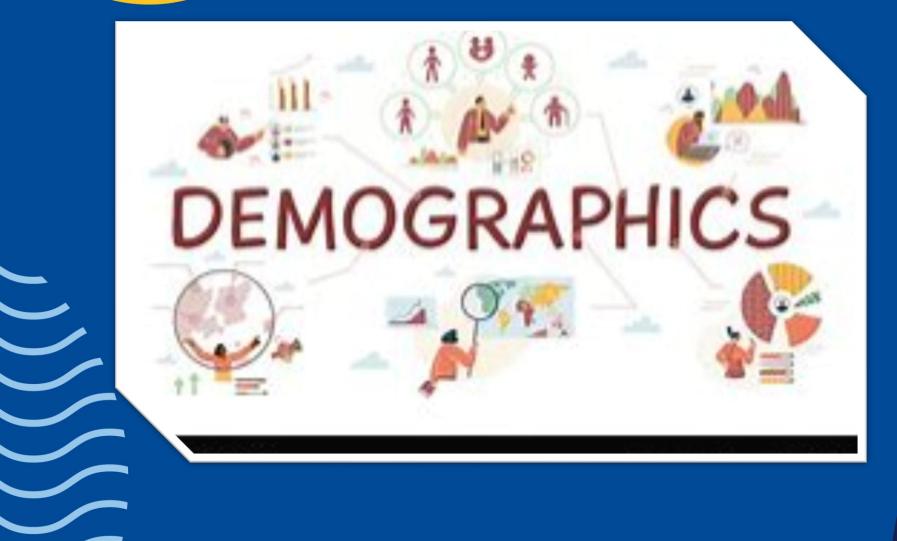

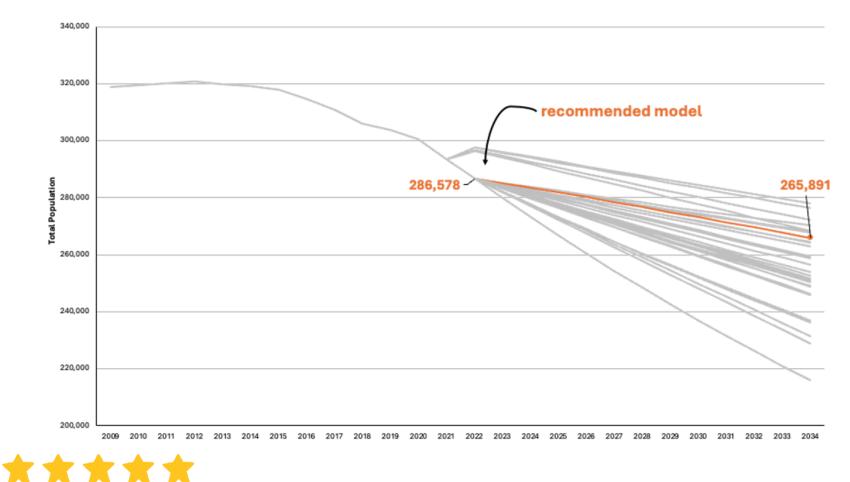

- Declines 7% in the next 10 years

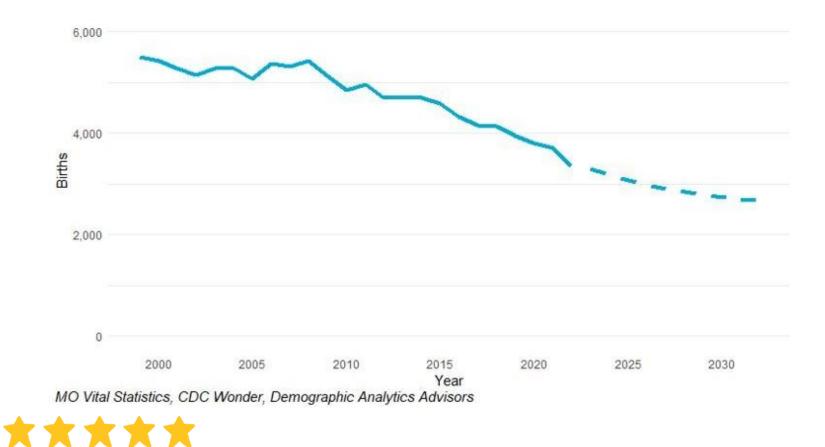

CITY OF ST. LOUIS BIRTH TREND DATA

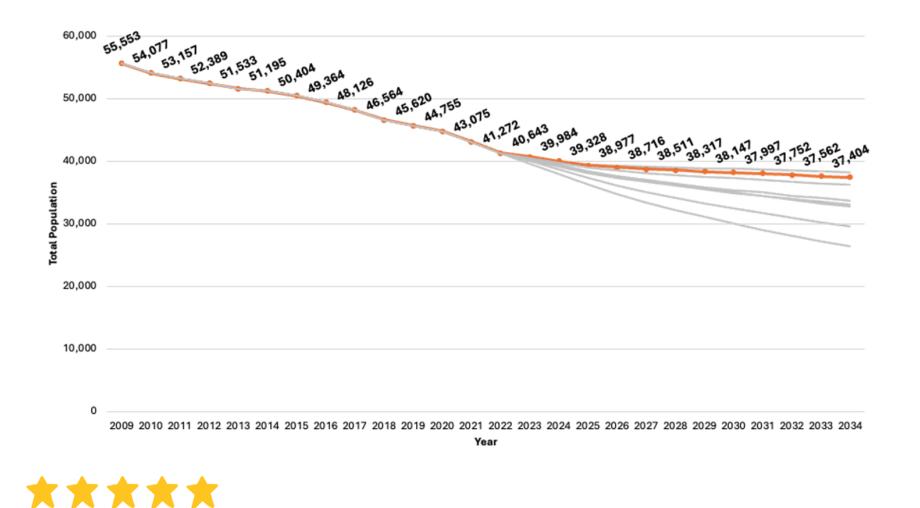
(1999 - 2032)

St. Louis City Births Forecast: 1999 to 2032 projections beginning 2023



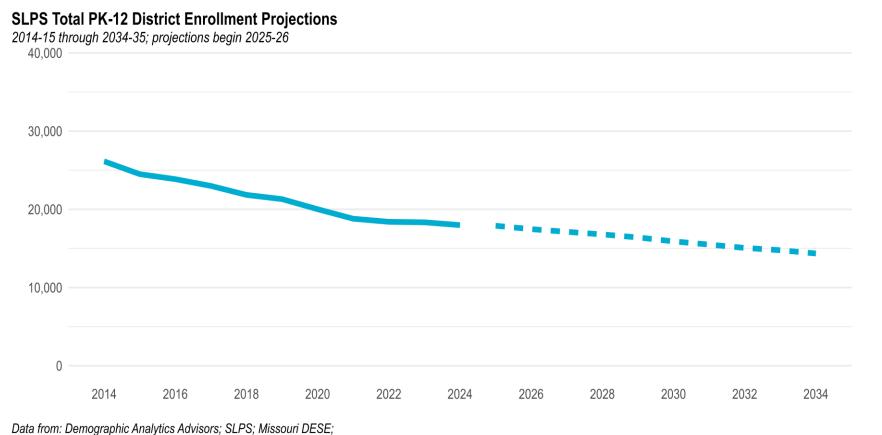


ST. LOUIS CITY POPULATION DATA (Age 3 -17years)(2022 – 2034 trend data)





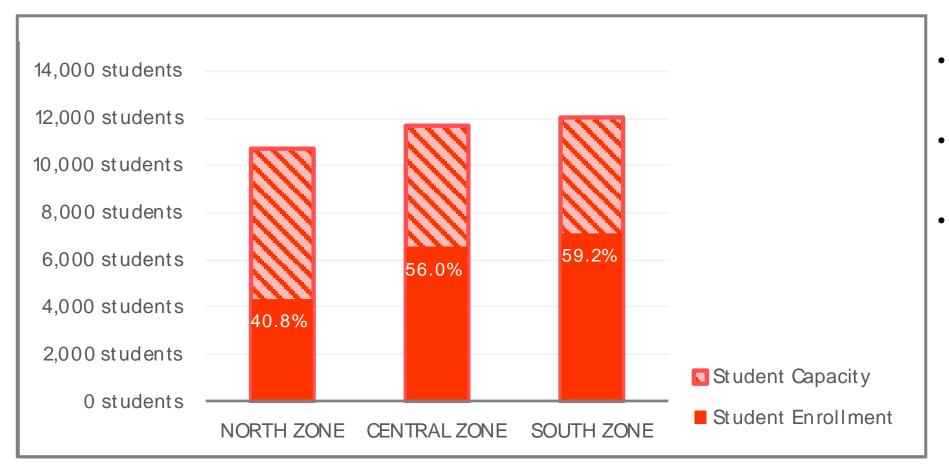
SLPS ENROLLMENT TREND DATA (2025 – 2034 trend data)







DISTRICT CAPACITY AND ENROLLMENT DATA



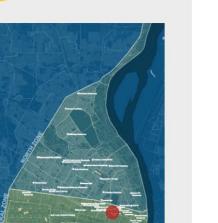

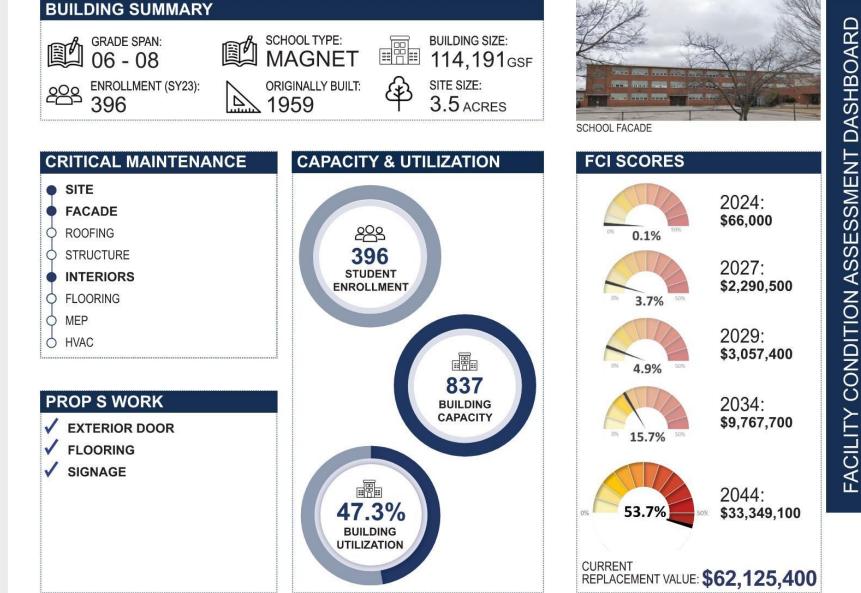

DISTRICT MAP



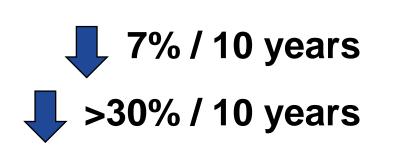
