

SYNOPSIS OF THE QUARTER 2 SCHOOL PLAN

SCHOOL: Pierre Laclede Junior Career Academy

PRINCIPAL: Dr. DaMaris A. White

INSTRUCTIONAL PLAN: Five-day-a-week in-person instruction or virtual learning, based on parent/guardian selection. Live-streaming model of hybrid instruction. Your child will remain with their grade level teacher. Your child will participate either virtually for children learning from home, or in the classroom, for children that are in the school building. Your child will actively participate in class through a two-way "live-stream" in Microsoft Teams, if attending virtually or from a second classroom. Your child will do the same work in the same applications at the same times per day for five days per week, whether they attend in person or virtually. Your child will have standards based and blended models of instruction. Your child will have an instructional schedule with synchronous and asynchronous time.

CLASSROOM CAPACITY: Each classroom will have an approximately 10 students depending on the size of the classroom with the special arrangements of social distancing.

SCHOOL HOURS: 8:05AM – 2:02PM plus one hour of asynchronous work to be completed at home. Please note that we are dismissing 1 hour earlier than usual.

ARRIVAL PROCEDURE: All bus riders, walkers and drop-offs will enter the building from Goodfellow at Door 7 (gym) for screening. Masks must be worn. Due to the limited space, we ask that parents pull up to the curb on the Goodfellow side. There will also be signage to remind you. Please call the school to let us know if your child will be arriving late and what time expect them. Late arrivals will need to sign in and be screened by school personnel. Students are to report directly to the main office to receive a tardy slip and then report to class.

DAILY HEALTH PROCEDURE: All students (PK-5) are required to wear masks that cover their noses and mouths while on the bus and the school campus. All staff and students will have temperature checks and pass screening questions upon arrival. If students are exhibiting signs of illness (chills, shakes, muscle pain, sore throat, loss of taste, fever, shortness of breath, cough) or have been in contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19, they should not be sent to school. Any students exhibiting potential symptoms during the day will be guided to a safe space until a parent/guardian picks them up. The school is following all city mandates regarding social distancing.

MEALS: Children will receive healthy meal options with hot food every day at school. Students will eat breakfast and lunch in their classrooms. Students will utilize restrooms at a staggered time before and after lunch. Hand sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the school building.

VISITOR PROCEDURES: To keep in practice of COVID measures, visitors will not be allowed in the school building without an appointment. All visitors must use Door 1 for access. Visitors will be screened and have their temperatures taken upon entry.

DISMISSAL PROCEDURE: Bus riders will be dismissed from their classroom. It is the expectation that they are social distancing. Floor decals will be on the floor to assist in reminding our students to social distance. School personnel will walk bus students to their appropriate bus. Pick-ups: Parents will park on Maffitt Street in front of the playground. Students will exit Door 5 to meet their parent on the playground. Students will not be allowed to walk to the car without being accompanied by an adult to ensure safety. Students participating in the aftercare program will assemble in the afterschool room. Early Dismissals: We are aware that there are times when situations occur, however, we ask that you allow your student to remain for the duration of the school day, unless it is an emergency. If you must pull your student out during the school day, please contact the school secretary with the exact time of arrival so we can take the necessary precautions to ensure that you retrieve your child and that we are following guidelines. Early dismissals will not be honored after 1:30PM.
