1. Question: Will a K-8 only solution be accepted?

Answer: No, the District is seeking K - 12 Solution

2. Question: Considering the current limitations due to COVID-19 outbreak, will the District accept digital proposal submission via email with electronic signature?

Answer: The District will not accept digital proposal submission via email with electronic signatures.

3. Question: Considering the current limitations due to COVID-19 outbreak, will the notary requirement be waived?

Answer: The District will not waive the notary requirements.

4. Question: We would like to confirm you are looking for a single solution for grade K-12 and would not consider a program for K-8 only?

Answer: See Answer No. 1

5. Question: Will the District accept a proposal that offers a solution for a subset of grades requested (such as K - 5 or 6 - 8)?

- 6. Question: Given current concerns about COVID-19 and recommendations to face-to-face contact, would the District accept e-signatures for all required forms?

Answer: We request that you only submit a proposals for the targeted number of schools, students, and grades.

11. Please confirm that the District will accept and/or review inclusion of the terms of service and privacy policy to the extent not inconsistent with the terms of the RFP. 12. Question: Please confirm that the District will inform IXL before any information marked as confidential is disclosed pursuant to any freedom of information statute

13. Question: Please advise regarding the process for requesting edits to the proposed contract language in Exhibit G and confirm that the District will consider proposed redlines. We have attached redlines that we would anticipate proposing based on the template language provided in Exhibit G.

14. Question: We are a corporation, what specifically are you looking for in section 5.2.1.1? Licensing and certification in the field of the requested services.
