



SYNOPSIS OF THE QUARTER 2 SCHOOL PLAN

SCHOOL: Lexington Elementary School

PRINCIPAL: Courtney Jude, courtney.jude@slps.org

INSTRUCTIONAL PLAN: Live-streaming model of hybrid instruction. Children will receive 2 days in-person, 1 day virtual, 2 day asynchronous.

CLASSROOM CAPACITY: Approximately 12-15 students. Larger classes may be held in larger spaces, such as the library or gym. At all times, we will follow social distancing guidelines.

SCHOOL HOURS: 8:05AM – 2:02PM

ARRIVAL PROCEDURE: Students will arrive via Door 2 (the door right next to the main entrance.) The nurse will be stationed at the door in order to screen students.

DAILY HEALTH PROCEDURE: Each student will go through a health screening from the nurse prior to entering the building. If students are tardy, their temperature will be checked by the security staff positioned inside of the front door. Students will be provided ample opportunities to wash hands and use hand sanitizer. Students will be at least 6 feet from each other at all times, and all students must wear masks will inside of the building. If students are exhibiting signs of illness (chills, shakes, muscle pain, sore throat, loss of taste, fever, shortness of breath, cough) or have been in contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19, they should not be sent to school.

MEALS: Breakfast and lunch will both occur in the classroom. Students will pick up their grab-and-go breakfast promptly after entering the school. During lunch, students will transition with their classroom to the cafeteria to pick up their lunch and return to their classroom.

VISITOR PROCEDURES: All visitors must call ahead in order to schedule an appointment. Upon arrival, a visitor must complete the health screening questionnaire provided, as well as have a temperature check.

DISMISSAL PROCEDURE: Bus students will be released from their classrooms and exit through Door 4, which leads onto the back lot where buses will be located. Buses will be called on a staggered schedule in order to mitigate additional student contact. Walkers will be released through Door 2 and allowed to walk home. Car riders will be kept in the gym in a socially distanced manner. Parents will pull up and park near the front door. Each parent will be provided a placard with their child's name. When they arrive, a staff member will radio inside the gym so that the child can be released.
