



SYNOPSIS OF THE QUARTER 2 SCHOOL PLAN

SCHOOL: Mason School of Academic and Cultural Literacy

PRINCIPAL: Dr. Stacey M. Franklin, stacey.franklin@slps.org

INSTRUCTIONAL PLAN: Live-streaming model of hybrid instruction using an AA/BB schedule. AA days are Monday and Tuesday. BB days are Thursday and Friday. ISC students may attend 5 days in-person. SPED inclusion and self-contained students may attend 4 days in-person.

CLASSROOM CAPACITY: Approximately, 10-12 students. Larger classes may be held in larger spaces, such as the library or gym. At all times, we will follow social distancing guidelines.

SCHOOL HOURS: 8:05AM – 2:02PM

ARRIVAL PROCEDURE: All bus riders will enter the building at Door 2. There, they will be screened and given breakfast, to report to their classroom. Masks must be worn to cover the nose and mouth. Car riders will enter the building at Door 3. Cars must enter from Magnolia (street behind the school) and exit at the alley once students have been dropped off. Cars may not enter the driveway through Southwest Avenue as in previous years. Staff will be available to receive students at drop-off. Please do not park and walk students up to the door. Please call the school to let us know if your child will be arriving late with the time to expect them. Late arrivals will ring the front bell, and school personnel will receive them; they will need to sign in and be screened.

DAILY HEALTH PROCEDURE: All students (PK-6) are required to wear masks that cover their noses and mouths all day and on the bus, unless eating or actively engaging in physical activities. Staff and students will have temperature checks upon arrival. If scholars are exhibiting signs of illness (chills, shakes, muscle pain, sore throat, loss of taste, fever, shortness of breath, cough) or have been in contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19, they should not be sent to school.

MEALS: Breakfast and lunch will be eaten in the classroom. Students will receive a Grab-and-Go breakfast as they enter into the building to be eaten once inside the classroom. Lunch will be eaten in classrooms. Parents who send lunch with their child are asked to omit general allergen foods such as nuts, shellfish and strawberries. Handwashing will take place before and after breakfast and lunch.

VISITOR PROCEDURES: There will be no in-person visitors unless they are approved District personnel or an approved District service provider. All appointments must be cleared by the office.

DISMISSAL PROCEDURE: Bus riders will be dismissed from the classroom. Cars must enter from Magnolia (street behind the school) and exit at the alley once students have been picked up. Exiting the driveway onto Southwest Avenue in front of the buses is prohibited for safety reasons. Students being picked-up: Grades 3-6 will report to the gym. Students will exit using Door 3. Students in PK-2 will report to the cafeteria. Students will exit using Door 2. Students in Grades 3-6 that have younger siblings will all dismiss from the gym. All students (all ages) will be walked to the car by staff personnel where photo ID will be checked and students will be signed out. Aftercare will be provided by AIMS.
