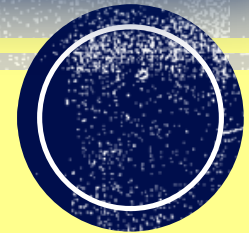

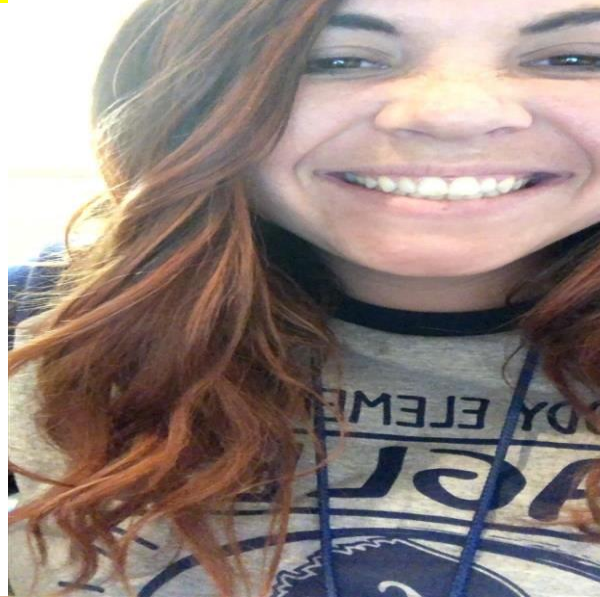

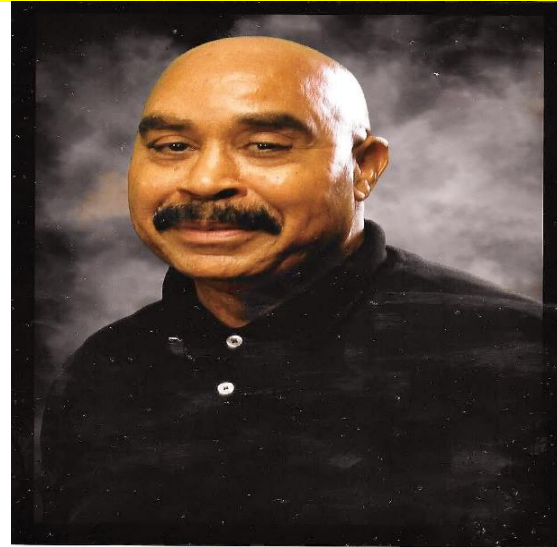

Parent Quick Reference Guide

- ✓ St. Louis Public Schools will begin the 2020-2021 school year fully virtual
- ✓ The first day of school for students is **Monday, August 31, 2020**
- ✓ The school day is from 8:15 am – 3:00 pm Monday - Friday

School Supplies & Technology Distribution

All students must come to Peabody Elementary to pickup school supplies and classroom materials for the start of the school year.

- ✓ PK students will receive school supplies, books, and learning packets
- ✓ K-5 students will receive an iPad, school supplies, classroom materials, and a virtual schedule
- ✓ Technology will be distributed **Wednesday, August 26th – Friday, August 28th** from **8:30am – 3:00pm** (enter through the gym door #6)

**Masks are required and temperature and wellness screenings will take place upon entry*



Sample Student Virtual Learning Schedule

What to Expect:

- The daily times for students to login to Microsoft Teams for class lessons
- Live course meetings for each content area with times for whole group learning, guided small group work, and independent worktime
- The teacher will inform students who will remain online for small group work and who will log off to complete independent work
- Scheduled lunch and technology breaks
- Scheduled office hours for parent communication
