







I will be available Monday - Friday from 7:30 until 3:30 and from 3:30-5:00 by appointment only. All messages will receive a response within 24 hour of being received.









## We are moving towards STANDARDS-BASED-GRADING.

This looks different from traditional grades. The reason for the shift is to make it more clear to students and parents exactly what skills a scholar has mastered; and which skills that scholar is still working to master.

Each student's overall grade with a standard will be on a 4-point scale.

**Emergent:** With support, student understands some simple parts of the standard.

**Progressing**: Student independently produces work that demonstrates understanding of simpler parts of the standard yet needs support with more complex parts of the standard.

Meeting: Student's standard level work shows no errors or omissions.

**Extending:** In addition to meeting the standard, student work exhibits in-depth inferences, and applications that exceed standard expectations.





For first quarter this year we will be engaged in 100% virtual learning.

We will use Microsoft Teams for:

- daily meetings/lessons,
- posting and turning in assignments,
- viewing recorded lesson videos.

Your child already has a Teams account and I will be sharing their log in information with you on class dojo prior to the first day of school, Monday, August 31.

We are DISTANCE LEARNING to help keep each other safe.



SYNCHRONOUS WORK: We are all on TEAMS at the same time for a live, in-person session.

Each student will have multiple live lessons daily, Monday- Thursday between 8:15 and 3:30. Friday, there will be no meetings to allow teachers to prepare lessons and grade assignments. Students must attend meetings:

- with **cameras ON** (there is a blur feature in Teams that will blur the background so we can see only the student)

- and **microphones OFF** unless they need to speak. This will help eliminate distractions from background noise.

There will be a CLASS MEETING every morning Monday-Thursday at 8:15.

Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. If the behavior continues after a warning, the student will be removed from the session and the incident will be recorded for administration to address.



If there are going to be issues with attending a meeting or if your child is ill and will be absent, you will need to contact the teacher as soon as possible via class dojo or email.



-Students are expected to be responsible and participate in all live lessons
-Students are expected to be respectful and not create distractions by drawing on the shared screen, playing with emojis, or adding unrelated comments to the chat.
-Students are expected to be learning buddies and not create disruptions that make learning more difficult for others.





### ASYNCHRONIOUS WORK: Each student works independently, to complete assignments before a due date.


- Students will have asynchronous work daily that relates to our live lessons. This is critical school work and to be completed by due date.





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
