What is PBIS at Herzog?

PBIS stands for Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS). Here at Herzog, PBIS is represented by our ROAR expectations

- · Respect yourself and others
- · Own your choices
- Act Safely
- · Ready to learn

PBIS is a process for creating safer and more effective schools. We use school-wide expectations that look the same no matter where you are in the building. Our goal is to have students following these ROAR expectations all the time. We track whether kids follow the expectations with CLASS DOJO. Students can earn up to 10 points per day.

- 1. Attendance
- 2. Uniform
- 3. AM Respect yourself and others
- 4. AM Own your choices
- 5. AM Act Safely
- 6. AM Ready to learn
- 7. PM Respect yourself and others
- 8. PM Own your choices
- 9. PM Act Safely
- 10. PM Ready to learn.

When students follow these expectations 80% of the time, they are eligible to attend our monthly ROAR celebrations. This fall we had celebrations like: out of uniform day, frozen treat, popcorn and movie, and cookie decorating.

But what if they don't follow the expectations? Every classroom has a system in place to redirect and reteach students who are missing these skills. We want to encourage the positive behaviors by helping kids get there! We have a restorative justice practitioner who works with kids to make sure they understand HOW to ROAR.

RESPECT YOURSELF AND OTHERS (SCHOOL)

Families and staff,

This month our PBIS focus is on the first R: Respect yourself and others.

As we begin our 2nd semester, we will take an opportunity to "REBOOT" our PBIS expectations and routines at school during the 1st week back. Lessons the rest of the month focus on respect.

Focus on being kind to yourself and others. Focus on complimenting others and accepting compliments from others. Focus on being respectful to yourself and others. We want to highlight respect as a way to keep conflicts from getting out of control.

RESPECT YOURSELF AND OTHERS (HOME)

Families,

We are including YOU in our PBIS newsletters from now on! We want there to be a great connection between home and school so we can help our students as much as possible. This month, encourage your students to talk about respect and point out times when they are showing respectful behavior at home and in the community.
