Distance Learning Week 3:
April 20-26, 2020**

Hello, American Lit Students! This week, we will continue our **Unit 3, on Conflict and Integrity**. Although we will not be following the original syllabus exactly, we will still be investigating the **essential questions**:

- Is personal integrity more important than survival?
- What is community and what is an individual's responsibility to their community?
- How does conflict influence a person's behavior?
- What is the impact of herd mentality?

Last week, we read an informational article about herd behavior and watched a short video about the same. **This week**, we will be reading a narrative piece about code switching, "**Learning How to Code Switch: Humbling, But Necessary**" by **Eric Deggens**. Code switching is the practice of changing your language or how you speak based on the context of a situation. For example, you might code-switch to a more formal style if your boss calls you on the phone in the middle of a conversation with your friends. As you read the article, think about the herd behavior topic from last week. How are these things related?

To accompany this article, I will also include **supplemental video links showing code switching in action** that you will want to check out (Key and Peele, Beyonce, Obama, etc.).

To complete this week's assignments, please do the following:

1. Read the article about code switching and take a few notes. The article is also attached to this post as a PDF, or you may use your CommonLit account and find the article here:
