



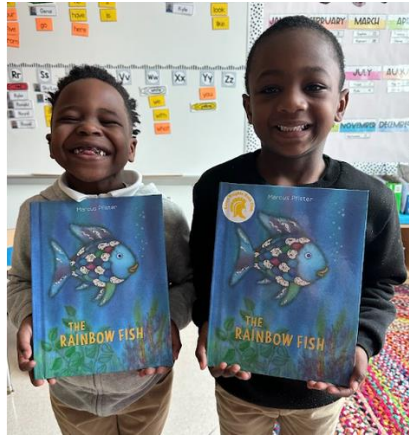

Nance Elementary students will be empowered as change agents to make a positive impact on the world.



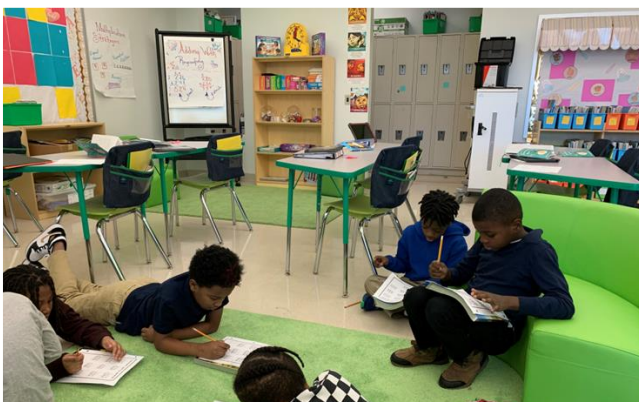
Welcome to Nance Elementary, a 2024 National and State School of Character!
