



## Shenandoah Virtual Learning Expectations

### Basic Rules:

- Identify a suitable workspace to work
- Log in 5 minutes before the virtual classroom session begins
- Be respectful
- Be in the work
- Complete and submit assignments
- Dress appropriately (Just as if you are going to school)

### Student Responsibilities:

- Log in daily or assigned meeting times
- Ask/Answer questions
- Complete and turn in work on time
- Work independently or in groups (when assigned)
- Be an active member of the virtual community

### Unacceptable Behavior:

- Vulgarity (no cursing, vulgar language, or inappropriate gestures, memes)
- Negative feedback on other's work and /or comments
- Posting negativity, bully others in chats

### General Reminders:

- Minimize background noise by turning off the TV and radio
- Stay Focused! Avoid multitasking during class!
- Mute your microphones until it is your turn to speak
