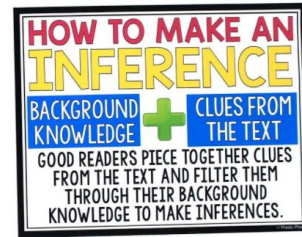
Listening Activity
