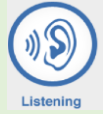

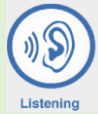
Listening

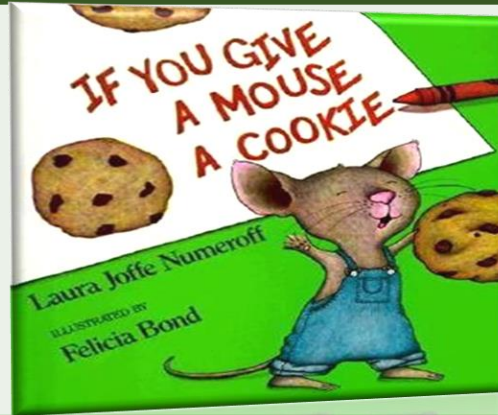
What did you learn?

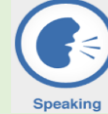


Listening

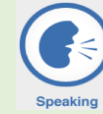


Speaking
