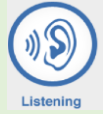
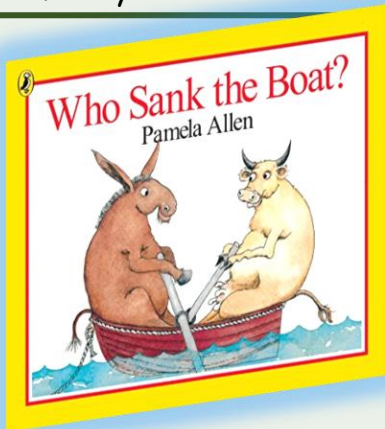

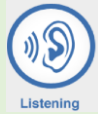

Sink or Float | Fun Science Experiment for Kids

 Why do some objects sink to the bottom and others float to the top? "I learned that it has to do with density! Every object is made up of molecules. Molecules are tiny little particles that are connected together. If an object's molecules are farther apart, the object is less dense and will most likely float on top of the water. If an object's molecules are tightly packed together, the object is more dense and will most likely sink to the bottom."
