

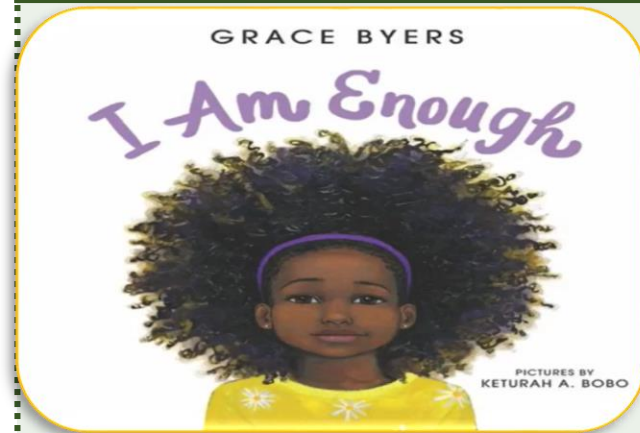

[Click here](#) to learn about people around the world! "Ni Hao!" is a way to greet in Chinese. Tell a family member what you learned!



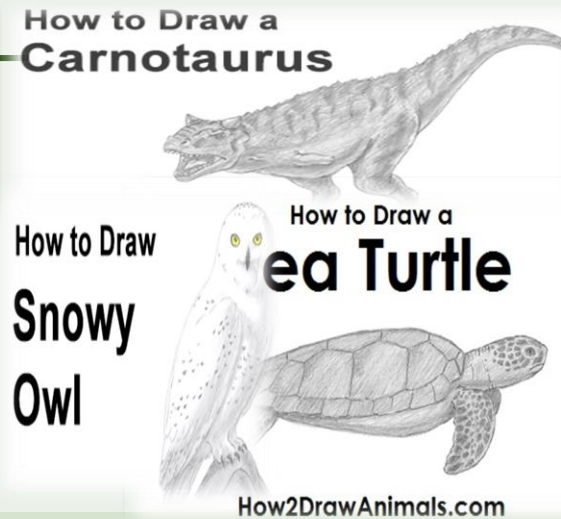

[Click here](#) to choose an animal to draw. Draw it and label its body parts. Tell a family member about your drawing and what you labeled.



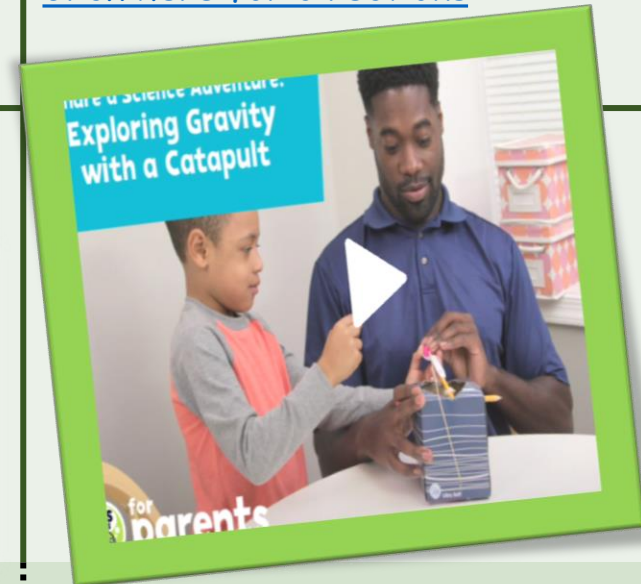
