






McKinley Classical Leadership Academy Graduation Requirement Guide

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St. Louis Public Schools minimum requirements

A planned four-year program of twenty-four units of credit is the minimum requirement for a diploma from a St. Louis Public Schools High School. It is also necessary to demonstrate mastery of state Competencies for Personal Finance and pass the United States and Missouri Constitution which are included in the required Government Course.

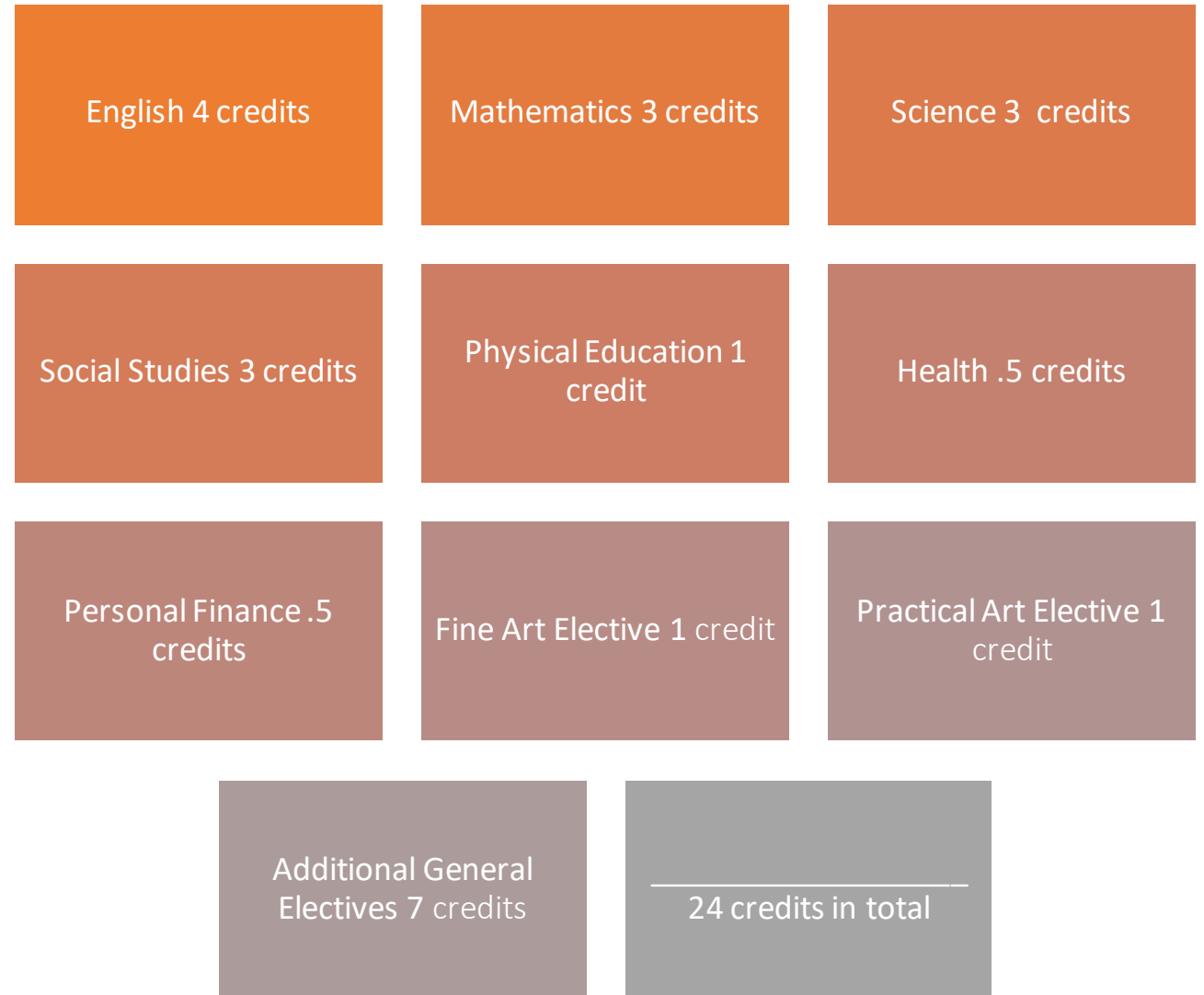
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Students can earn $\frac{1}{2}$ or .5 units of credit for each semester long course. For example, First Semester Algebra 1 = .5 credits, Semester 1 + Semester 2 Algebra = 1 credit.

Students should earn an average of 6 credits
per year to stay on track for graduation.

Freshman 0-6 Credits

Sophomore 7-12 or above

Junior 13-18 or above

Senior 19-24 or above

How can students stay on track to graduation?

1

Enroll in at least 6 credit earning classes per semester

2

Pass all classes (this is especially important Freshman and Sophomore Years)

3

Attend Summer School for failed or missing coursework

4

Follow a balanced schedule that include 4 core classes and 2 electives

5

Schedule a yearly transcript review meeting with your school counselor
