OPT OUT LETTER

Dear High School Parent(s)/Guardian(s) and Student:

Federal law requires the Saint Louis Public Schools to provide names, addresses, and telephone numbers of 11th and 12th grade high school students to military recruiters and institutions of higher education that request this information, except where the parent or student opts out by notifying the SLPS in writing that he/she does not consent to release this information. The opt out notifications are provided to all ninth through twelfth grade students, as well as their parents.

While we are committed to protecting the confidentiality of our students, we must comply with the law. Parents/guardians and students who do not want contact information disclosed to military recruiters and/or institutions of higher education must fill out an opt out form and return it to the school's guidance counselor or school data processor by October 30, 2020.

Please be aware that you can change your options at any time. If you do not submit the form now, you may still opt out at any time. Please advise the principal in writing if you change your decision at a later date.
