

Student safety is very important to us. In order to assure that our food service department is informed about student food allergies, please contact me if your student has a food allergy that has been diagnosed by a physician. Also, please be on the lookout for a form coming home regarding food allergies. Please be sure to return this form so that we can protect our students from exposure to allergens.

If your student requires medication to be given during school hours, please be sure that you have submitted the authorization form required by the district. This form is required even for medications that are given on an "as needed" basis. Students with on-going medical concerns such as asthma, severe allergies, seizures etc. must also have an updated action plan on file each school year.

We have several opportunities for students to receive health screenings throughout the year. These include dental, vision, and hearing, and are provided at no cost to our families. These opportunities take place at various times during the school year and some require signed consent from a parent or guardian.
