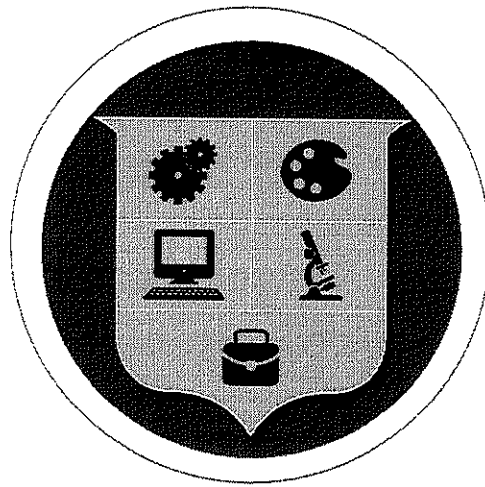

In order to promote Parent Involvement, Pierre Laclède JCA will provide a variety of services to meet the needs of our families through the use of Title I funds. These services will include Communication, Shared Responsibilities, and Building Opportunities for parent involvement

Communications/Strategies for Involvement:

Pierre Laclède JCA will hold an annual meeting to inform parents of the school's participation in Title I, explain Title I requirements and explain the parent's right to be involved. Pierre Laclède will schedule several meetings at various times to ensure parent engagement occurs during Title I program planning and the development of the school wide plan.

PLICA will provide parent(s) of participating children:

1. Timely information about Title I programs
2. An interpretation of the school's annual performance report
3. An explanation of district curriculum, student achievement data, the forms of assessment used to measure student progress, and the proficiency levels students are expected to meet
4. Regularly scheduled parent conferences
5. Parent surveys and timely responses to parent concerns

Pierre Laclède will maintain minutes from all parent meetings as a record of comments regarding the planning of and implementation of the school wide plan.

Shared Responsibilities for high Student Academic Achievement

- Pierre Laclède's Family and Community Specialist will work collaboratively with school staff and parents to implement a parent involvement plan.
- Pierre Laclède's Family and Community Specialist will disseminate information to parents that will help parents understand the academic process and the importance of their involvement in the learning process for their children.
- Pierre Laclède's Family and Community Specialist and other Support Staff will monitor daily attendance and call parents if children are not at school.
- Pierre Laclède's Family and Community Specialist will develop with parents of participating children, a school-parent compact which outlines how parents, the entire Pierre Laclède staff and students will share responsibility for improving student's achievement. It will also describe how staff and parents will build a partnership to help students achieve the Missouri Learning Standards.

Pierre Laclède's school-parent compact will:

1. Describe Pierre Laclède's responsibility to provide a high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment.
2. Describe how parents will be responsible for supporting their child's learning ,such as monitoring attendance, homework completion, and TV viewing, volunteering in their child's classroom, participating, as appropriate, in decisions relating to the education of their child and positive use of extracurricular time.
3. Describe opportunities for parents and teachers to communicate on an ongoing basis including , at a minimum by:
 - a. Parent-teacher conferences in elementary school, twice a year, during which the compact will be discussed in relation to their child's achievement
 - b. Frequent reports to parents on the progress of their child.
 - c. Reasonable access to Pierre Laclède's staff and opportunities to volunteer, participate and observe in their child's classroom.

Building Capacity/Expanding Opportunities for Involvement

Pierre Laclède will ensure effective involvement of parents and support a partnership with the Title I school, parents and the community to improve student academic achievement.

Pierre Laclède will provide assistance to participating parents with topics such as:

1. Understanding the Missouri Learning Standards, the MAP (Missouri Assessment Program) and Local Assessments.
2. Understanding How to Monitor a Child's Progress.
3. Understanding How to Work With Teachers to Improve the Academic Performance of Their Child.

Pierre Laclède will provide parents with the following supports:

- Materials and training necessary to improve their child's achievement, such as training in literacy and the use of technology.
- Work closely with school staff at Pierre Laclède will to promote open communication and working with parents as equal partners while implementing and coordinating parent programs, and bridging the gap between home and school.
- Coordinate and integrate the Title I parental involvement programs and activities with other existing parent involvement programs.
- Disseminate important information regarding school and parent programming in an appropriate manner.
- Provide parent resources and opportunities focused on child development and parenting.
- Provide other reasonable support for Title I Parental Involvement as determined by results from parent surveys.

Pierre Laclède and the St. Louis Public School District may:

- Work with Pierre Laclède parents to enhance the involvement of other parents.
- Pierre Laclède will provide necessary literacy training if all other available sources of funding have been exhausted.
- Pierre Laclède will arrange school meetings at a variety of times or other locations to maximize parental involvement and participation.
- St. Louis Public School District will establish a districtwide Parent Advisory Council (PAC) to advise on all Title I parental involvement matters.
- Pierre Laclède will develop appropriate roles for community organizations and businesses in parental involvement activities.
