The Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) is a program that was developed by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) to ensure that all children have access to nutritious meals when school is not in session. Saint Louis Public Schools will be holding summer school sessions at schools throughout the Saint Louis city region. All children under the age of 18 are entitled to a free breakfast and lunch meal daily, whether they are in summer school or not. Anyone over the age of 18 will have the option of purchasing a breakfast or lunch for \$1 per meal. The summer school sites are listed below. Summer school sites will be open from **June 6th to June 30th.**
