

## SYNOPSIS OF THE QUARTER 2 SCHOOL PLAN

**SCHOOL:** Woerner Elementary School

PRINCIPAL: Peggy Meyer, margaret.meyer@slps.org

INSTRUCTIONAL PLAN: Five-day-a-week in-person instruction or virtual learning, based on parent/guardian selection. Live-streaming model of hybrid instruction. Your child will keep the same teacher and the same class of kids. Your child will either participate from the classroom with the teacher, or virtually with added support from a dedicated staff member assigned to that class. Your child will actively participate in class through a two-way "live-stream" in Microsoft Teams, if attending virtually. Your child will do the same work in the same applications at the same times per day for five days per week as all other classmates, whether they attend in person or virtually. Art and music classes will remain virtual. Your child will have recess with his/her own class exclusively. Your child will receive any and all needed and approved supports and related services, where applicable. We will NOT be requiring uniforms for students at this time.

**CLASSROOM CAPACITY:** 15 students. Larger classes may be held in larger spaces, such as the library or gym. At all times, we will follow social distancing guidelines.

**SCHOOL HOURS:** 9:10AM – 3:07PM

**ARRIVAL PROCEDURE:** Students will enter through the back doors in the morning. Bus riders will enter at Door 2 and walkers/car riders will enter at Door 6. *These are the same doors we always use*. They will have their temperature taken daily at the door. If tardy, students must come to the front door, and they will have their temperature taken there.

**DAILY HEALTH PROCEDURE:** All students (PK-5) are required to wear masks that cover their noses and mouths all day and on the bus, unless eating or actively engaging in physical activities. Staff and students will have temperature checks upon arrival. If students are exhibiting signs of illness (chills, shakes, muscle pain, sore throat, loss of

taste, fever, shortness of breath, cough) or have been in contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19, they should not be sent to school. If your child is feeling sick or has a fever, please keep him/her at home. If they are feeling up to it, they can join their class virtually for those days and will not be counted absent. Please err on the side of caution.

**MEALS:** Students will eat breakfast and lunch in their classroom. Breakfast will be delivered to each classroom by the cafeteria staff. At lunchtime, students will use the restroom and wash their hands before they are escorted to the cafeteria to pick up their lunch. Hot lunches will be served on a tray, as before, and the students will bring their lunch back to the classroom to eat. Social distancing guidelines will be followed during this process.

**VISITOR PROCEDURES:** No in-person visitors will be allowed in the building. Parents are welcome to call, email or text. We can also set up Zoom meetings, if needed.

**DISMISSAL PROCEDURE:** PK parents will pick up their child at Door 2 (gym). Bus riders will exit at Door 5 and board buses on the school yard. Parent pick-ups will take place in the back only at Door 6. Parents may walk onto the school yard, as in the past, but must wear a mask and must remain 6 feet away from others.
