

SYNOPSIS OF THE QUARTER 3 SCHOOL PLAN

SCHOOL: Carnahan High School of the Future

INSTRUCTIONAL PLAN: Five-day-a-week in-person instruction or virtual learning, based on parent/guardian selection. When in-person, if any student violates our safety protocols, such as refusing to properly wear a mask, failing to follow classroom expectations, and/or any discipline issues, they will be moved back to virtual learning instruction full-time.

CLASSROOM CAPACITY: Approximately 10 students. Larger classes may be held in larger spaces, such as the library or gym. At all times, we will follow social distancing guidelines.

SCHOOL HOURS: 7:10AM - 1:07PM

ARRIVAL PROCEDURE: Female and male students will enter through separate doors to keep the entry process smooth. All students should enter with masks properly covering their mouth and nose. Also, students will be expected to have their laptops fully charged before arriving to school. All students will complete a health screening and temperature check and then complete the normal entry procedure.

DAILY HEALTH PROCEDURE: Each student will go through a health screening prior to entering the building. Students will be provided ample opportunities to wash hands and use hand sanitizer. Students must socially distance and wear masks while inside the building, unless they are eating or drinking at designated meal times. If students are exhibiting signs of illness (chills, shakes, muscle pain, sore throat, loss of taste, fever, shortness of breath, cough) or have been in contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19, they should not come to school.

MEALS: Students will eat in designated areas while practicing social distancing.

VISITOR PROCEDURES: Only one visitor allowed per family (No more than one member per family will be able to enter). Only one visitor in the building at a time (All other visitors will wait in car until called in by member of Carnahan team). All appointments with administration, counselors, etc. must be arranged prior to arrival. All visitors who enter the front of the building will be expected to sanitize

and get their temperature checked. If temperature is outside of the safe zone, they will not be allowed inside of the building.

DISMISSAL PROCEDURE: Students who ride the bus will be dismissed by cohorts (designated groups). Students who get picked up will wait in a designated area while their ride will pick up from staff parking lot. Students who walk will be dismissed last.
