## SENIOR CURBSIDE CLEARANCE

Due to COVID-19 and social distancing guidelines, SLPS is conducting a Curbside Senior Clearance (CSC) at all high schools on May 24 – 25, 2021.

The purpose of CSC is to allow you to return school-issued textbooks, uniforms and technology and pickup personal belongings curbside—all without leaving your vehicle. If you are without transportation, you can walk-up to return items. Please be mindful of social distancing and wear protective gear.

In preparation for CSC, counselors will begin calling seniors during the week of May 10<sup>th</sup> to review clearance information and schedule appointments, if necessary. In addition, you will also receive information on the following:

- Current grades (final grades will not be available until after final exams)
- Textbooks, uniforms or technology issued that must be returned
- Date and time for Curbside Senior Clearance
- Any school fines (*Please contact your Principal for more information.*)

You can also schedule an appointment using Microsoft Teams or via email. Alternate dates for CSC can be scheduled with your school counselor by appointment only. (*Please check your school's website for more information on Curbside Senior Clearance.*)

**During Curbside Senior Clearance, an SLPS safety officer will be present to ensure social distancing guidelines are followed.** In addition, we ask that students and parents adhere to the following:

- Use the drive-through drop off/pick up process while on campus.
- Students/parents must wear masks covering their noses and mouths.
- Students/parents are to ask to remain in their vehicles except when dropping off books and picking up personal items.

**During Curbside Senior Clearance, seniors must return ALL uniforms, textbooks and District-issued technology (unless enrolling in SLPS virtual summer school).** At this time, you will also have the opportunity to:

- Receive your cap and gown
- Receive all personal items gathered from your school-assigned lockers
- Return items and pay fines (*cash or money order*)

## TECHNOLOGY RETURN

**STUDENTS MUST RETURN ALL SLPS AND SCHOOL ISSUED TECHNOLOGY PRIOR TO RECEIVING THEIR DIPLOMA OR TRANSCRIPT.** Technology can be returned during the Curbside Senior Clearance or after your final exams. Contact your school administrator for more information.

## TRANSCRIPTS AND DIPLOMAS

Official transcripts of your academic record are available at no cost if your account with the District is in good standing (*all equipment returned and fines paid*). All students should complete the Graduate Survey at their schools or at [www.slps.org/2021exitsurvey](http://www.slps.org/2021exitsurvey) (for virtual students) to indicate where your transcripts should be sent. Your school counselor will communicate more information regarding the survey. For your convenience, transcripts will be mailed to those verified addresses on or after June 3, 2021.

Students with accounts in good standing (*all equipment returned and fines paid*) must return to their school sites to retrieve diplomas between May 28 – June 4, 2021. Please contact your school for specific times.

## SUMMER COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS SUPPORT

The SLPS Online College and Career Readiness (CCR) Center will operate from June 7 to August 6 to assist you with transcripts, FAFSA, award letters, college applications, online college visits and college questions. Assistance with trades or employment is also available. The center will be available online from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. every Monday through Thursday.
