1. A **fortuitous** event is one that happened by chance. To be **fortuitous** is to be lucky.
2. **Assessment** is the process of making a judgement about a person or situation. At school, **assessment** normally refers to testing.
3. When you place **emphasis** on something, you give it special attention to show its importance. Bold print in a text is way to show **emphasis**.
4. To **transport** people or goods means to carry them from one place to another. A common way to **transport** students is by bus.
5. The **dimensions** of something are its size. **Dimensions** include the measurements of height, width, and length.
