3. Another word for **potential** is possibility. **Potential** is the possibility that something might happen.
4. The **incidence** of something is the number of times it happens. The **incidence** of cancer increases as people get older.
5. To **expose** something is to leave it uncovered or without protection. Wearing a face mask can keep you from being **exposed** to a virus.
