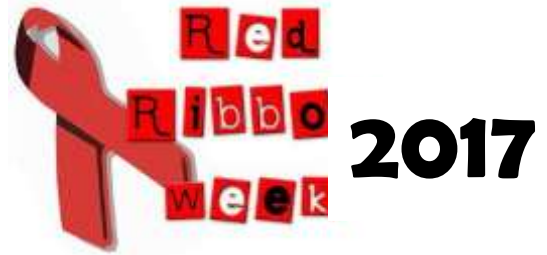

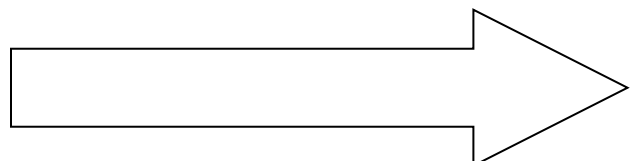
**Bryan Hill's Salute to Red Ribbon Week!**
