COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIPS

A minimum of 15 scholarships will be awarded yearly in the amount of \$2,000, renewable for up to four years.

Selection Criteria: Award based on all of the following criteria: Academics (minimum ACT of 20, minimum GPA of 3.0), volunteer work, community service, leadership within your community, financial need, and a personal interview. Strong consideration will be given to those candidates who are interested in a possible future career or internship with Evergy, especially students in the following career fields: business, finance, accounting, engineering, human resources, computer technology, communications/marketing or other similar career fields. Scholarship administration and selection is performed by The Ellis Foundation.

Eligibility requirements:

- Must be a Kansas or Missouri resident attending a Kansas or Missouri high school
- · Must be an upcoming graduating high school senior
- Must enroll and maintain a full-time status in your degree program to receive scholarship award
- Must maintain a 2.5 GPA in your degree program
