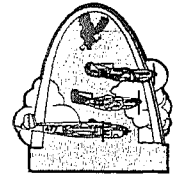

Dear Sir/Ma'am,

Each year the organization of National Tuskegee Airmen, Incorporated (TAI) awards forty, \$1,500 scholarships to deserving high school seniors. The scholarships are equal opportunity based primarily on academic performance, financial need, and two essays. We are extending an invitation to your high school seniors to submit applications for a scholarship. A copy of the application is provided. Feel free to make additional copies as needed. You can find a list of requirements included at the bottom and back of the application. Completed scholarship applications must be received no later than January 26, 2018. Historically, forty percent of the applications submitted by the Hugh J. White Chapter of TAI have been selected for a scholarship. Last year however, 4 of 5 names forwarded received a national scholarship and one received a local educational grant. Although I cannot help your seniors write their essays, I am available to review their applications and discuss strategies on how to improve their application package.

In addition, the Tuskegee Airmen, Incorporated (TAI) host events for younger students. Central Region of TAI has hosted a free youth aviation camp during the summer. Information on the camp will be provided later. The second event is hosted by Southwest Airlines to select teens and their escorts who will travel to Southwest's Corporate Headquarters in Dallas, Texas. Each chapter of the Tuskegee Airman, Inc. will be able to nominate one student for an all-expense paid trip. Finally, ten students from our region will be able to attend the Tuskegee Airmen Youth Aerospace and STEM Academy. 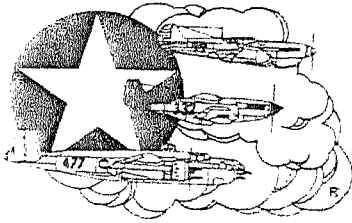
