GOALS

- To provide continuity of learning in a remote environment
- To provide continuity for staff and student engagement in a remote learning environment
- To meet the state requirements to provide equitable and ongoing education

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- Take responsibility for your learning by participating, completing the assigned work and abiding by each teacher's online classroom expectations
- Commit to the learning duration outlined by the school's bell schedule
- Ask teachers for help if you are confused by a lesson or feel like you are falling behind
- All online communication should be school appropriate. Keep microphone muted unless contributing to class discussion or posing questions to teacher via chat function
- Submit all work according to teacher's deadlines
- Questions outside of work being done for that day's lesson should be directed to teacher via email. Email addresses can be found on school website
- Students should refrain from conversations with others in class, using other electronic devices during class time and be respectful at all times

STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINARY ACTION

- All guidelines, as set by SLPS in the Code of Conduct booklet, will be adhered to (profanity, harassment, bullying or other inappropriate behaviors)
- Having video camera on is not mandatory. If you elect to have it on, attend your classes in an appropriate area (study area, family room, kitchen)
- As in school, video recording is prohibited. Sharing or posting of any such videos is illegal and a violation of educational privacy laws
- All communications should be for educational purposes only. Remember: What you share online has a digital footprint and cannot be undone. (just like all social media platforms)
- Disciplinary action beyond the efforts of the teacher will follow the protocol below:
 1. Parental phone call by administration
 2. Parental Appearance Notice with administration at Soldan
 3. Removal from Teams from said class for a specific duration of time

5 KEYS TO A SUCCESSFUL ONLINE LEARNING EXPERIENCE

1. Log into classes on time (attendance will be taken)
2. Be fully equipped for learning (laptop charged, engage w/o distraction)
3. Follow all teacher's instructions (microphone muted, appropriate chat)
4. Complete all work assigned by teachers (honor deadlines, ask for help when needed)
5. Appropriate attire and work environment when video is activated
