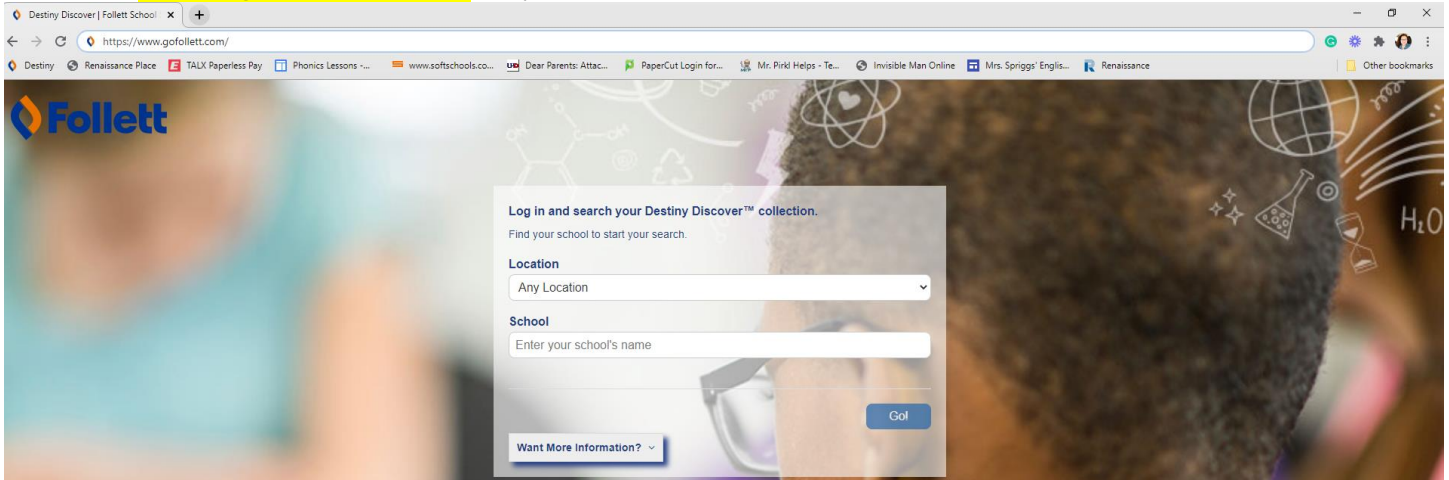


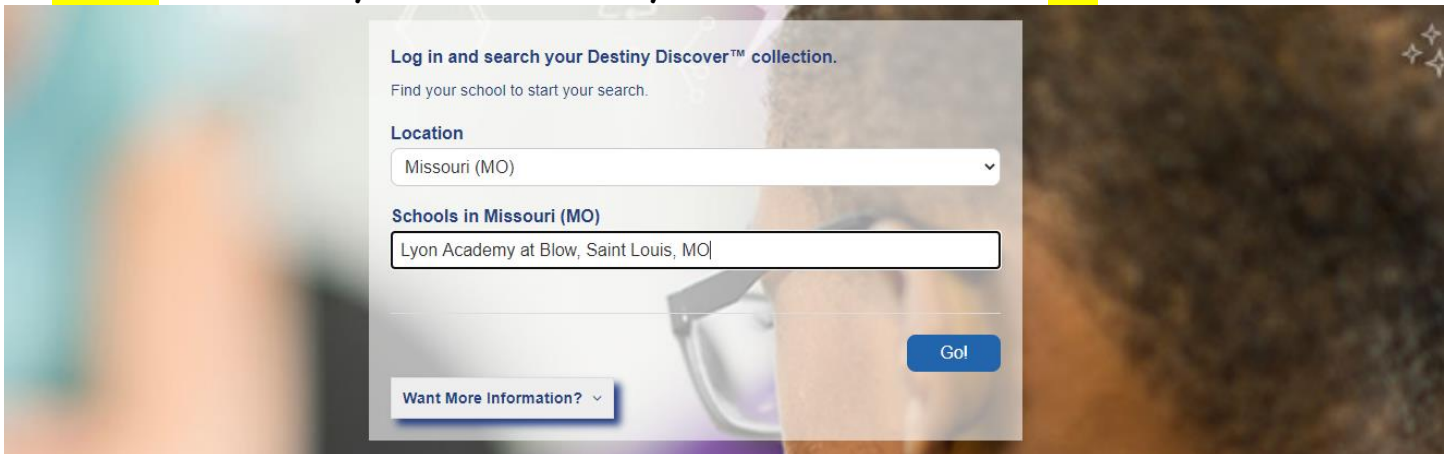
ACCESSING EBOOK COLLECTION IN ST. LOUIS PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Browser Instructions

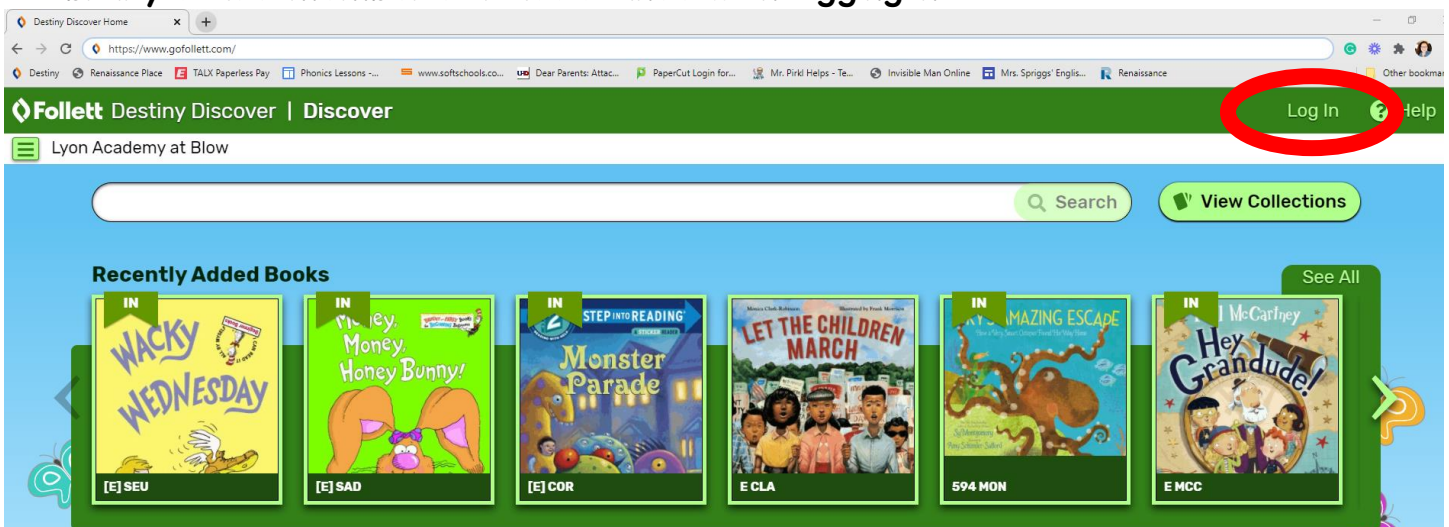
1. Visit **www.gofollett.com** in your web browser.



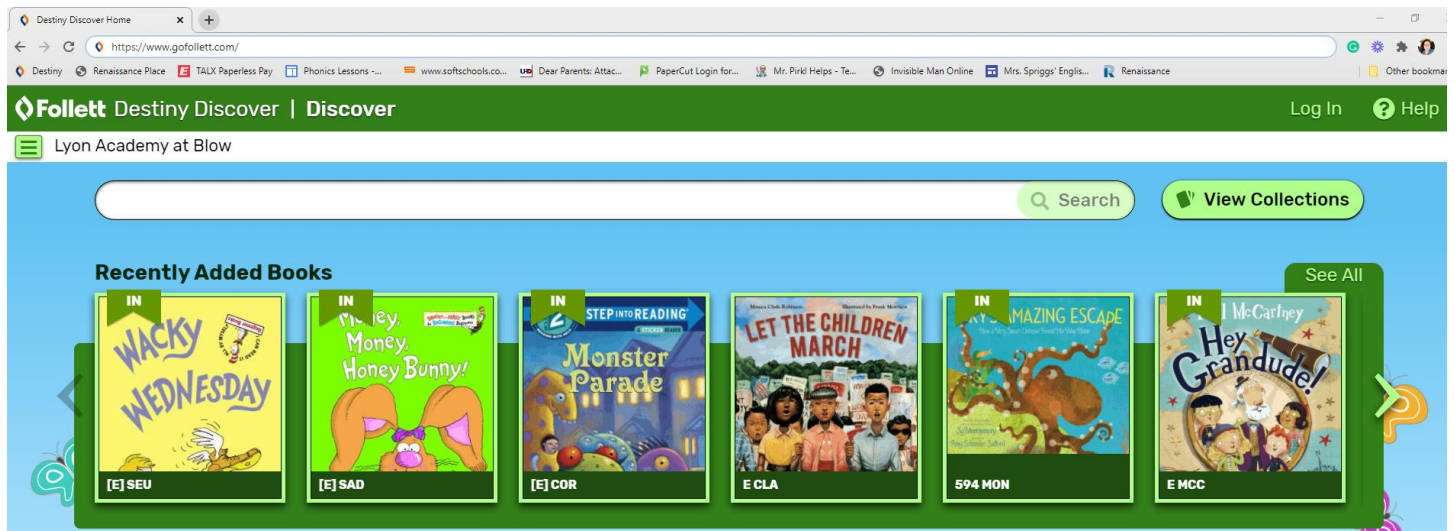
2. Select **Missouri** from the Location drop-down menu and **type in the name of your school** to access your school library eBook collection. Click **Go!**



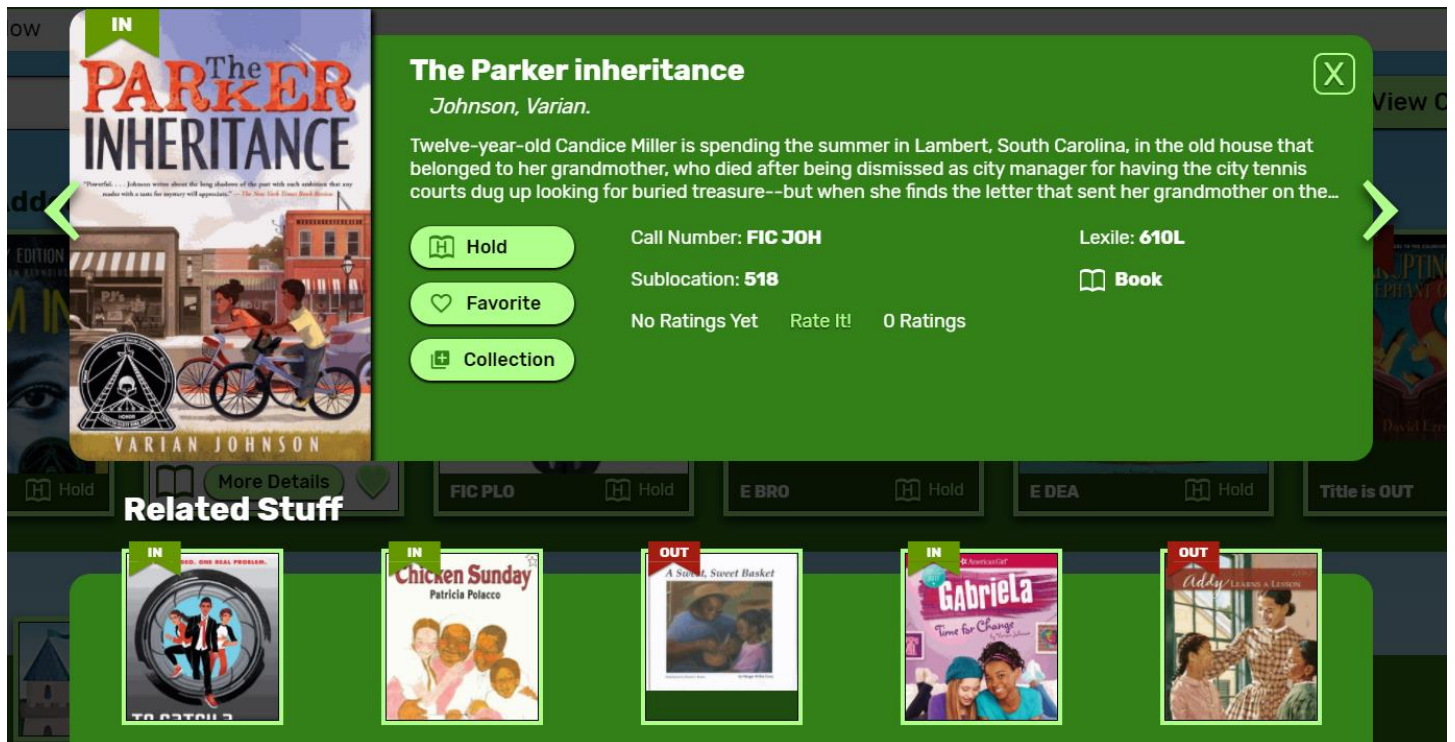
3. Click **Log In** in the upper right-hand corner to check out books. **Your username is usually your student ID number** and the password is **Follett**. Contact your school library staff member for assistance with logging in.



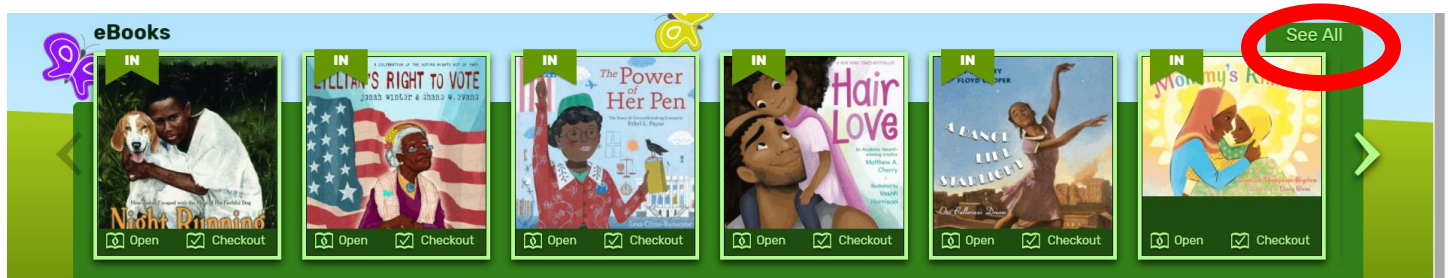
4. Browse the collection to find titles of interest.



5. To access information about a title, click the title to explore the card. Clicking "More Details" will provide a summary of the title as well as related titles that may also be of interest. As students and teachers leave ratings, those may be read as well.



6. To view a particular category, select the category from the preview on the main page. To view eBooks only, click "See All" in the eBook preview row.



7. Search by any filter (title, author, subject, genre, keyword, reading level, series, and more) or select a book from the preview window!

8. To check out the book, click the title and then select "More Details". From here you can open the book to read it within the browser if the title is available.

9. Many eBooks have an option to have the book read using your computer audio. As the text is read aloud, the words will be highlighted on the page. Other text tools include annotating, highlighting, text size adjustment, and bookmarks.
