SUBJECT: To approve a contract with Raineri Construction LLC to renovate the Cafeteria at Central VPA/Cleveland High School for Proposition S bond construction. This work shall begin on July 22, 2011 and be completed by August 13, 2011 at a cost not to exceed \$112,675.00, which includes a 10% contingency of \$10,243.00.

BACKGROUND: The Cafeteria at Central VPA/Cleveland High School is in very poor condition. Upgrades to this area will include new flooring, ceiling, energy efficient lighting and painted walls to enhance the student dining environment. The contractor will design-build the project. This work will not interrupt the Cafeteria operation. This work will be funded by the Proposition S Bond Program under the Cafeteria and Kitchen Upgrades category estimated at \$3,100,000.00. With this project approved, the balance of the Cafeteria and Kitchen Upgrades budget is \$2,403,010.00.


