




2016-17 Magnet and Choice Schools Wait List Status as of 6/21/16







Gifted Programs Non-SLPS KG-12 Wait List Applicants as AIN of 6/21/16



Future Status of Non-SLPS Magnet/Choice 2016-17 Wait List Applicants



Other than...

- Magnet Preschool Applicants (and 27 Stix KG)
- k Ineligible Magnet and Choice High School Applicants

...ALL applicants from outside the SLPS who met the Pool A and B Lottery Deadlines have received an offer for placement to a magnet/choice school requested.

Placement requests submitted after Pool A and B Lottery deadlines are processed first come – first served, and make up all remaining non-SLPS students currently on the non-gifted schools wait lists.

In addition...

- & City Resident preschool applicant names have been provided to Early Childhood Education Office
- Gifted applicant evaluation is ongoing
- The few high school applicants from outside SLPS unable to be placed due to eligibility matters typically attend their home district/county high school, with the exception of two charter schools who will get a letter encouraging them to consider the neighborhood SLPS high school where applicable
- & As of May 26, only applications submitted to schools with open seats are processed for placement
