

McKinley's Overview for In-Person Learning

<p>1. School Times</p>	<p>7:00a – 2:17p Monday – Friday</p>
<p>2. Procedures for Entering the Building</p>	<p>The entry points will be door 12 (Missouri Ave), main entrance (Russell Blvd). All students will be required to wear a mask and adhere to daily wellness screenings. (Staff undergo the same daily wellness screenings.) If anyone displays a temperature and/or any other symptoms they will be quarantined. Students are required to have their district issued device. We are asking that the district's electronic device, maybe a writing utensil and 1 folder/notebook be the only items brought to the school in a book bag (A clear one is preferred but not required). *Please do a prescreening at home. If your child exhibits any signs of not feeling well please keep them home.*</p>
<p>3. Students who are tardy to school.</p>	<p>Parents will be required to walk students to the entrance of the school and make sure the student passes the daily wellness screening. If they do not pass, the parent will be asked immediately to return the student home.</p>
<p>4. Classroom Structure</p>	<p>All classrooms have been posted with maximum capacity numbers and information shared with teachers. Teachers have prepared their classrooms to adhere to the 3 feet social distancing. We will accommodate scheduling to adhere to social distancing guidelines. Not all classrooms hold the same number of students. Teachers will create seating charts to assist with contact tracing if necessary. Students will have access to lockers. We will furnish locks as well. We are asking students only bring necessary materials to school.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All desk will be facing in the same direction. • Sanitation/cleaning supplies will be in each classroom for teachers/students. (Students are able to bring their individual hand sanitizer bottles • No shared supplies in the classrooms. • Students will clean their area each time before they exit the classroom. • All rooms on the 1st-3rd floors have functional windows. • All instruction is in person.

<p>5. Transitions</p>	<p>To limit number of students in the hall we will stagger the times tentatively by 1-2 minutes per grade level.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> All students walk to the right of halls.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Stairwells will be directional as well. The west stairwell is the down direction and the east stairwell is the up direction. <input type="checkbox"/> Restrooms will be off limits during transitions in order to monitor and track student traffic. <input type="checkbox"/> We have bottle filling stations for students to fill water bottles. Students are allowed to bring 1 personal water bottle to school.
<p>Breakfast</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Students will have a grab and go breakfast that they will eat in the classrooms.
<p>Lunch</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> We will have 4 lunches in the cafeteria where students are socially distanced. Students are able to bring lunch from home. Microwaves will not be in use.
<p>Dismissal</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Dismissal will be staggered. Early dismissals will take place through a main entrance check point system to limit people in the building. If you require an early dismissal, your student they must be picked up from the school by 1:40 p.m. to not interfere with the dismissal process. Walkers and car riders will be dismissed after the busses have departed.
