I Made a Rainbow at the Salad bar, otherwise known as Rainbow Days is a promotional event for elementary schools to increase student's participation in the salad bar. The sister program for middle and high schools is called FreshLIFE: Enjoy a Salad Today. These programs provided grant funding totaling \$1,000 with individual schools receiving \$200. Lyon at Blow Elementary School received funds from Rainbow Days. Gateway Stem High School, Long Middle School, Vashon High School and Yeatman-Liddell Middle School received the FreshLIFE Grant. Farmers markets will be held during lunch at Vashon High School on April 12th, Gateway Stem on April 19th, Long Middle School on April 26th, Yeatman-Liddell Middle School on May 3rd and Lyon at Blow Elementary School on May 10th.
